Bish, Bash, BOSCH!

You will each be required to create your own triptych loosely inspired by Hieronymus Bosch's 'The Garden of Earthly Delights' and the 'Book of Miracles'.

Triptych definition:

- a picture or relief carving on three panels, typically hinged together vertically, and used as an altarpiece.
- a set of three associated artistic, literary, or musical works intended to be appreciated together.

Research:









Research The Garden of Earthly Delights. Identify 8 key characteristics of the painting, e.g. what colours does the painting use? Are the colours symbolic in any way? How does the painting depict the afterlife and the transition from heaven to hell? How would you describe the painting? – scary, surreal, vivid, colourful, chaotic, beautiful, grotesque, challenging, apocalyptic, etc.

Research the 'Book of Miracles'.

This book contains the contents of a 16th century German manuscript depicting supernatural phenomena, folklore and apocalyptic visions. The illustrations are beautiful, surreal and intricate. What ideas does the work give you? How are you inspired by these illustrations and themes?









 You must create your own triptych inspired by this research, consisting of 3 PANELS. The content of your outcome is entirely up to you. It could depict current events, a fictional story you have created, mythology, science fiction, heaven and hell, etc. This is a very open task and we want you to express who you are as an artist and the art you enjoy.

You can explore a variety of media and materials, and it can incorporate a mixture of painting, photography, illustration, drawing, or collage, by hand or digital. It is up to you how you create your triptych, but be imaginative and think carefully about the mood, landscapes, creatures, style, colours, and themes depicted in your work.







Be creative, there is no right or wrong approach! Just make sure it is interesting and individual.







- Set up a Pinterest account and begin pinning your ideas. Call your board 'The Liminal Space: Thresholds Between Worlds'.
- Set up your own Instagram account for posting ideas and development. You must then follow our official L1 & L2 account @L2_LCH_ART. This account can be used for contacting us (your course directors) and receiving official course updates.
