- Describe and compare the entry requirements for each service (e.g., fitness tests, qualifications, background checks)
- Discuss the pros and cons of structured routines in service life
- Explain why personal qualities such as honesty, trustworthiness, commitment and adaptability are essential for service roles
- Reflect on your own attitudes and values, explaining how they may support or challenge your employability

Your Practical Portfolio or Presentation Should Include:

- A breakdown of at least three different uniformed service roles (e.g., firefighter, paramedic, RAF technician)
- Details of the application and recruitment process for at least two services
- A table or comparison of the advantages and disadvantages of the service lifestyle
- An explanation of the importance of key personal qualities in the services
- A reflective section discussing your own strengths and areas for improvement in relation to employability
