Over the summer I would like each of you respond to the theme Left Behind. Each of you should take 50 photographs using **2 x 25 shot disposable cameras**. The rules are simple the objects photographed must be abandoned or left behind.













What you photograph and how you photograph is up to you as long as each image created is of something different. Your project could have a running theme or be very random. This project is about getting out with your camera looking for and finding interesting subject matter that could extend further photographic ideas.

You may want to consider;

Photographing objects found on a journey
Visiting an abandoned building or area
Illegally dumped objects or rubbish
Evidence of human existence, someone has been there and left.
You could even collect random objects and photograph them on a sheet of white paper.

I don't want to give you too many ideas this is your chance to think personally and creatively. If you want to add extra work or extend this project in any way, please do.

Please print your colour films at 6x4 and bring them into college during the first week. Your 2 sets will be mounted in blocks of 25 here at college so you may want to arrange the layout and order at home first. The images gathered during the summer will form the basis of your first project in the Apple Mac room.
