## Year 1 Summer Project work – ‘The Lost Path’

Firstly, set up an Instagram account specifically for the college course (if you haven't done already). All images for this project must be uploaded to this Instagram account. We will look at these when you return in September.

Over the summer I would like each of you respond to the theme ‘The Lost Path’. Each of you should take at the very least 50 photographs. 25 shots will need to be taken on a colour disposable camera, and you will need to get these photographs printed. You will be asked to bring them during your first week for review.



What you photograph and how you photograph is up to you as long as each image created is of something different or taken in different locations. Your project could have a running theme or be very random. This project is about getting out with your camera looking for and finding interesting subject matter that could extend further photographic ideas.

You may consider:

- Photographing forgotten areas, overgrown, hidden pathways
- Nature reclaiming urban environments (an obvious response)
- Signs of previous life, existence
- Forgotten memories or fading objects
- Lost property or abandoned buildings

I don't want to give you too many ideas, this is your chance to think personally and creatively. If you want to add extra work or extend this project in any way, please do. You can shoot and process film, scan images and objects. Your images can be reworked digitally.

The images gathered during the summer will form the basis of your first project in the Apple Mac room, so make sure they are saved and ready to use!
