L1 Award in Introductory Welding

- **Who is this course suitable for?**

This course is designed to provide students with a sound grounding in welding studies and is intended for those who need to obtain basic skills in welding. The course is very hands-on and takes place in our well-equipped workshop.

What can I expect to learn?

Course covers the following topics:

- Health and Safety in the workshop
- Tools and safety equipment
- Safe and correct use of welding sets

How long is the course?

1 evening a week over 11 weeks. Only one of the modules above is attainable within the 11 weeks of the course.

- **How and where do I study**

This course is delivered at West Suffolk College.

- **Are there any exams or assessments?**

The programme includes five mandatory practical assessments and an oral test which covers the knowledge requirements for the programme of study. The oral test will be carried out by the assessor following the successful completion of the practical tests

Will I achieve a qualification or certificate?

Yes, successful completion of all assessments will lead to achieving L1 Award in Introductory Welding Skills

- **Are there any costs**

Yes, employers are required to pay 20% contribution towards the costs of this course which is £159
