### Building a Lego Brick Bridge

#### What do we need to do?

We would like you to build a bridge with a very long span and a maximum of 4 piles (upright supports) using only lego bricks, lego plates are allowed but they must be no longer than 8 points long, like these →

#### What are the entry levels?

Each competition has two entry levels, one for Key Stage 1 and one for Key Stage 2.
