Have kids work in teams to construct their own neighborhood.


- 1. Cut out work order form, name badges, and construction signs.

- 7. Set up construction signs around your neighborhood. Once the area is safe, start arranging houses to build your neighborhood!

TIP

Ask kids to explain their house design and list the steps they think are needed to build their house on the work order sheet prior to building. Have kids cut out and prop up the construction signs.
